**DECISION DOCUMENT**

Based on the Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Slovenia and the Government of France on Cooperation in the Fields of Culture, Science and Education, signed in Ljubljana on 6<sup>th</sup> November 1992, on the Agreement on Scientific Cooperation between the Ministry of Higher Education, Science and Technology of the Republic of Slovenia (MHEST) and the National Institute on Agronomic Research of the French Republic (INRA) signed on February 9, 2005, and on the call for proposals for joint research projects, announced by the Slovenian Research Agency (SRA) and the INRA respectively in March 2006, the two sides realize that:

The SRA received 6 (six) proposals for joint research projects and the INRA received 5 (five) proposals for joint research projects.

The project proposals have been peer reviewed by both sides and the MHEST and the INRA have come to an agreement to co-finance 3 (three) matching proposals received by both sides.

The approved projects are listed in Annex 1.

The approved projects will be funded for the period of 2 (two) years, i.e. from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2007 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2008.

The total amount covered by the Slovenian side will be 15.000 € in SIT equivalent per year and the total amount covered by the French side will be 10.000 € per year. The details of the money allocated to individual projects are evident from Annex 1.
