DECISION DOCUMENT

On co-funding of Slovenian - Japanese joint projects in FY 2007 (April 1, 2007 – March 31, 2009)

Based on the Memorandum of Understanding on Scientific Cooperation between the Ministry of Education, Science and Sport the Republic of Slovenia and the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science signed in April 2001 and on the call for proposals for joint research projects and joint seminars, published by the Ministry of Higher Education, Science and Technology of the Republic of Slovenia and the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science respectively in 2006, the two sides realize that:

The Ministry of Higher Education, Science and Technology of the Republic of Slovenia received 10 (ten) proposals for joint research projects and the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science received 9 (nine) proposals for joint research projects.

The Ministry of Higher Education, Science and Technology of the Republic of Slovenia and the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science evaluated the nine (9) matching proposals received by each side and have come to an agreement that according to the peer review screening they will jointly fund the following joint research projects in the FY 2007 (April1, 2007 – March 31, 2009):
